## Waste Categories

Waste Category	Materials which can be included All waste must be solid (no liquids, sludge or powders)	Other Info
General Construction and Demolition	All non-hazardous general construction materials such as wood, plastic, metal, rubble, soil, glass, cardboard etc.	Max 10% Plaster- Board. No tar contaminated materials.
Household	All non-hazardous general household and garden materials such as wood, plastic, metal, rubble, soil, glass, cardboard etc.	Max 10% carpets/floor coverings. Extra charges may apply for mattresses.
Industrial, commercial and municipal	Most non-hazardous industrial, commercial and municipal waste is acceptable but a detailed description of waste must be provided before acceptance.	
Wood	Hardwood, Softwood, Chipboard, OSB, Plywood, Melamine, MDF, Hardboard, Formica etc. (Metal also ok)	No 'green waste' No Sleepers. No creosote or tar contaminated wood
'Green Waste'	Trees, shrubs, plants, soil	No Root balls greater than 300mm diameter
Rubble	Bricks, concrete, stone, ceramic tiles, glass. (Reinforced concrete is acceptable but will be subject to an additional charge)	No Reinforced or laminated glass. No material greater than 200 mm thick unless additional charges agreed prior.
Soil	Top soil, Turf, Clay, Subsoil. Small natural occurring stones.	No Bricks or concrete
Soil and Rubble Mixed Tyres	Soil and rubble see above All car, van and bike tyres with or without rims. Plant and HGV Tyres by prior arrangement.	Plant tyres, HGV tyres on rims and solid tyres will be subject to additional charges
Plasterboard	Plasterboard and Plaster	Limited amounts of wood, metal or insulation attached to the boards will be ok
UPVC	UPVC window frames and doors with attached metalwork	No Glass or other plastic.

Where waste is a mixture of categories the highest tariff will apply All waste must be Non Hazardous

All waste must exclude Liquids, Powders, Clinical waste, Asbestos, Animal waste, Fridges, Freezers, Fluorescent Tubes, Cathode Ray Tubes (TV's).
